### Tasks:

- Previous CSCC College Credit Plus students-YOU DO NOT NEED TO APPLY AGAIN. We will just need your CSCC Consent Form.
- Apply to Columbus State : <https://www.csc.edu/admissions/ccp-app.shtml>  
\*\*See application notes below
- Complete the attached “College Credit Plus” Consent Form **WITH YOUR COUGAR ID ON IT** AND turn in to the counseling center. Incomplete forms will be returned.
- Eligibility:
  - If you have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, you do not need to submit ACT/SAT scores OR take placement tests. The counselors at WKHS will send GPA information to Columbus State.
  - If you DO NOT have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher, you will need to submit ACT/SAT scores to Columbus State directly from ACT or SAT. Their college code is 1148.

- Use personal email address and not wscloud account
- Need your social security number

- **MALES:** If you are 18, you will need to register for the selective service and forward your selective service number to your school counselor. If you will be turning 18 during the 21-22 school year, you will need to register for the selective service soon after your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday and forward your selective service number to your school counselor.
- After you submit your application, you will receive an email from Columbus State indicating that they have received your application. In 2-7 days after that, you should receive an email from Columbus State with your acceptance and your Cougar ID. **SAVE YOUR COUGAR ID!**
